 Dated the Twenty ninth day of of January 1733  
 Surveyed unto Henry Acker a tract of Land Sit-  
 uate in Oley in the County of Philada<sup>a</sup> Beginning  
 at a Black Oak thence by Vacant Land North  
 forty degrees East one hundred and Eighty perches to a  
 hickory thence by Vacant Land North fifty Degrees West  
 one Hundred and forty two perches to a post thence  
 by Vacant Land South forty Degrees West one hundred  
 and Eighty perches to a post thence by Vacant Land  
 South fifty Degrees East one hundred and forty two  
 perches to the place of Beginning Containing one  
 hundred and fifty acres with the usual allowance  
 of Six p Cent Surveyed April 26 1734
