Situate in Coniout Township Crawford County Pa on the waters of Big Coniout and there appeared to be cleared fenced and cultivated upwards of forty acres of the land and there was surveyed and marked out one hundred ac &c in the south west corner of said tract as Represented by the dotted lines, for the use of William Clark Esq and the said Amos Beard, was Residing on his own part of the Land
