



A Draught of a tract of land situate in St Clair Township Allegheny County on the West side of the Monongahela River immediately above the mouth of Pecks Run containing ninety five acres two Roods and three perches & allowances of six pr. cent for Roads &c. Surveyed Feb. 9th 1825 in pursuance of a Warrant in the name of Jacob Bausman dated September 22^d 1789 for two hundred acres on the Bank of the Monongahela River between Pecks Run & J. Lucas De Pentux

Note at the time of executing the above survey there was two families residing thereon and about 8 or ten acres under cultivation.
