



On the 22^d Decr. 1785 a Survey was made on a Warrant in the name of Jas. Cooke, dated the 6th August 1784, and return'd to the Surveyor Genl. Office by Messrs. Nevill and Ritchie, which Survey contained 388 AC^s 136 ps. and the all^s and of which the above Fig. taken together is a Draught. Saml. Marquis claimed part of the Survey then (obl.) and entered a caveat; on the 20th of Oct. 1797 they accommodated the dispute, the above Draught of 192 AC^s 64 ps. & wth allowance is now return'd agreeable to said accommodation on the above Warrt in the name of Jas. Cook dated ye 6th Augth 1784 for 400 AC^s.
