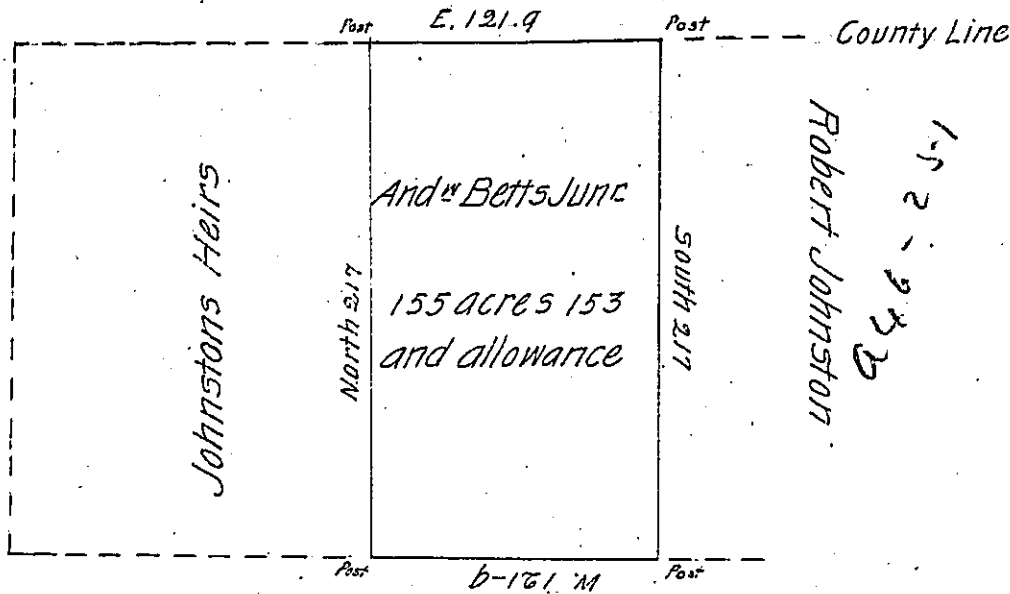

Land Called the Strip

This is a draft of a tract of land Situate in West Salem Township Mercer County and bounded as above, containing one hundred and fifty five acres and 153 perches and allowance, being a part of a four hundred acre tract Surveyed the 21st day of October 1826 in pursuance of the actual settlement and improvement of Andrew Betts June commenced in the month of April 1813 — and continued the present with his family and engaged in improving the same, his improvements are a Cablins House and Barns and about thirty acres Cleared fenced and Cultivated

I hereby Officially Certify that from the Books and other documents in my Office it does not appear that the above land has been granted to any person other than the present applicant by Warrant or otherwise. November 21st A.D. 1826
