In Pursuance of a Warrant for 100<sup>ac</sup> dated the 10<sup>th</sup> day of September AD 1750 and Resurveyed the 5<sup>th</sup> day of October AD 1773—

And now at the request of the Present Owner Peter Glassbrunner we are desired to make return of the Draught as calculated and examined and by our Calculation find it to contain One Hundred and fifty eight acres and forty one perches and the usual allowance &c the sixteenth day of September Anno Domini 1803
