



A Draught of a tract of land situate formerly in Kellam Township but now in Windsor Township in the County of York containing as above set forth One Hundred and sixty-one acres and fifty seven perches and allowance. Originally surveyed for Joseph BoGLE by George Stevenson late D.S. In pursuance of a Warrant for 100<sup>acs</sup> granted to the said Joseph BoGLE bearing date the 10<sup>th</sup> day of September A.D. 1750. Resurveyed on the 3<sup>th</sup> & 9<sup>th</sup> days of August A.D. 1804 by the settled & admitted lines of the then present adjoining for Peter Glassbrommer the present owner. And now on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 1812 at his request I am desired to make Return of the Draught as calculated, examined and found to be correct.
