

* This return is no doubt out of place as it respects the
date of the warrant but I am not to blame in this
matter. The warrant was directed to Tm McCall-
ister D.S before my coming into Office Besides
the man to whom the warrant was granted gave
me no notice of it until the 10th of March 1840.
