



Draft of a tract of land situate in Scrub Grass township, Venango County West of the Alleghany river on the waters of little Scrub Grass creek containing three hundred and sixty acres and Eighty nine perches and allowance adjoining land settled by James Majors (now warranted to Barnabas Olt.) on the West. On the North, land settled by Robert Selder and George McCool, now warranted to Isaac Barnett, Surveyed 1 February 1819, in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Thomas Parsons, dated the 15th January 1816.
