owance which was originally surveyed by Charles Pen-  
kins late D.S. on the 23d day of April 1767 (and by him  
said to be returned) In Pursuance of a Warrant for 200 a.  
Granted to Peter Cook bearing date the 1st day of May  
A.D. 1744. The above part resurveyed and divided off  
from the said larger Tract of Land on the 22d day  
of January 1790 by John Forsyth late D.S. And now at  
the request of the owner Henry Dusenham the above obliquely calculated  
examined &c on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of April A.D. 1811 And returned for Confirmation
