



In Pursuance of a Warrant granted to William Crawford bearing Date the 30th of June 1744. The above described Tract of Land was Survey'd by my Father as appears by ^{his} Draught thereof of which the above is a Copy Situate near Susquehanna River on the West Side thereof & near Peach Bottom Ferry New York but then called Lancaster County. It has since been Purchased by Robert Ewing Certified By George Churchman Townsship

I suppose this Survey was not Returned by my Father as his Fees for Surveying it were not Paid but in Part Till some Time latter by R. Ewing Paid the Remainder & desired a Return G. C.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this thirteenth day of April 1904.
