In pursuance of a warrant, to John Campbell Bearing date the twenty six<sup>th</sup>  
day of February 1800 Survey'd on the twenty eighth<sup>th</sup> day of November 1811  
unto the aforesaid John Campbell the above described tract of  
Land Containing one hundred and Fifty nine acres and one hundred  
and fiftynine and one half perches and allowance proportioned at six  
Pr Cent situate on the waters of the four Mile Run in Dunagall town-  
ship in the County of Westmoreland Including his improvement thereon  
Consisting of a dwelling house and Barn and about Fifty acres of land  
Cleared and fenced, &c First commenced to be improven in the begining  
of February 1800.
