



Draught of one hundred and seventeen acres of land with 6 P^r Cent for roads & C. Situate in Fermanagh township in Mifflin county, being part of a tract of land which was surveyed 31st July 1795 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Daniel Cookson dated 16th August 1786 and said to contain 200 Acres & 32 perches with usual allowance for roads & C. Resurveyed and divided 8th March 1808.
