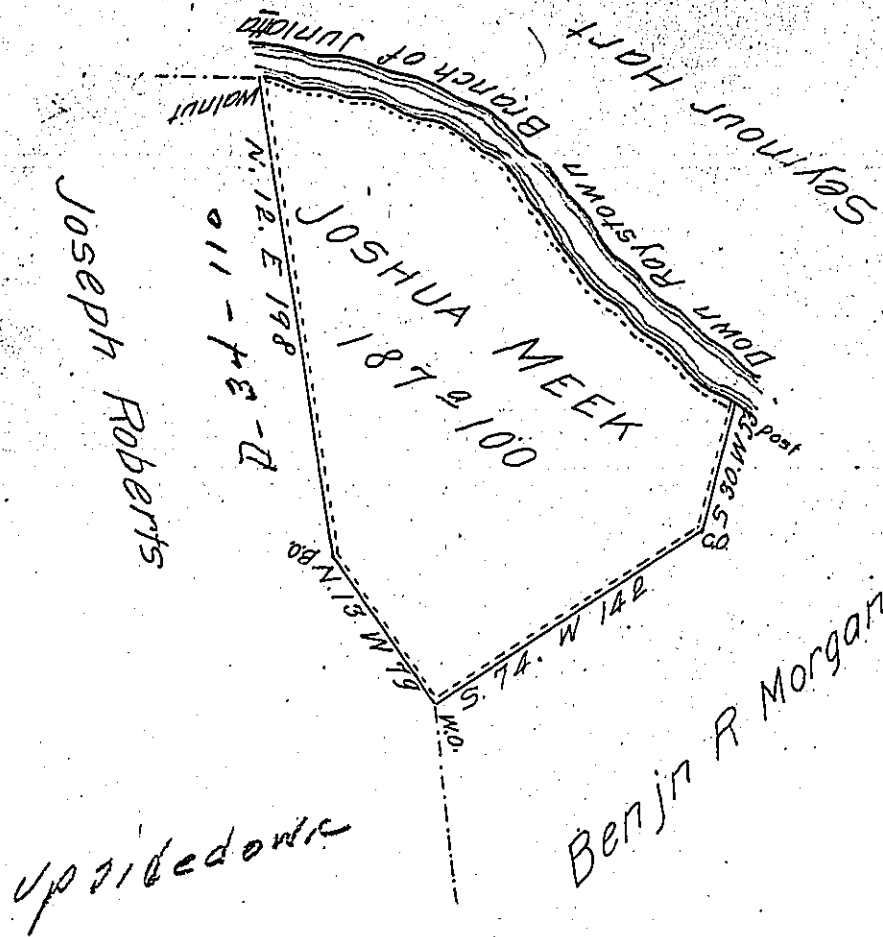

John Norris not Patented

The dotted lines represent part of the draught of a tract of
land Surveyed for John Norris on Warrant dated the 21st day of
December 1795. this tract inteferes one Hundred and Eighty Seven
Acres and 100 perches with the Joshua Meek Survey, Samuel
Perry who claimed under Joshua Meek conveyed to Alex^r Huston
who conveyed to Arthur Chambers, who conveyed to John Norris who
obtained the afore said Warrant and is the present owner.

conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of
