



A Draught of a tract of Land Situate about two Miles west of the Susquehanna River and of the Lower End of Old Shishiquin Flats in the township of Ulster County of Bradford Containing three hundred and eighty nine acres and Sixty perches and allowance of six per cent Including an improvement Consisting of a log Dwelling house and ten or more acres of Improved land Comminced in April 1808 Surveyed the 21<sup>st</sup> day of August 1813 in pursuance of a Warrant dated the 15<sup>th</sup> of July 1813.
