



Situate in Potter Township Huntingdon County, containing two hundred thirty five acres & the usual allowance. It being part of a tract of land the original lines of which are dotted in the above Diagram. It was first surveyed the 9th day of May A.D. 1766. In pursuance of a warrant granted to George Craighood, dated the 17th day of July 1762, said survey was then said to contain 642 acres & the usual allowance. This part re surveyed and divided from the residue of said tract the 16th day of January A.D. 1830.
