Said to have been surveyed on the 5th day of May 1794 in pursuance of a warrant dated the 9th of November 1793 granted June Cochran as appears by an Official Copy of the return of Survey made into the Surveyor General's Office Resurveyed on the 7th day of September 1826 in pursuance of an order of the Board of Property dated the 30th March 1826.
