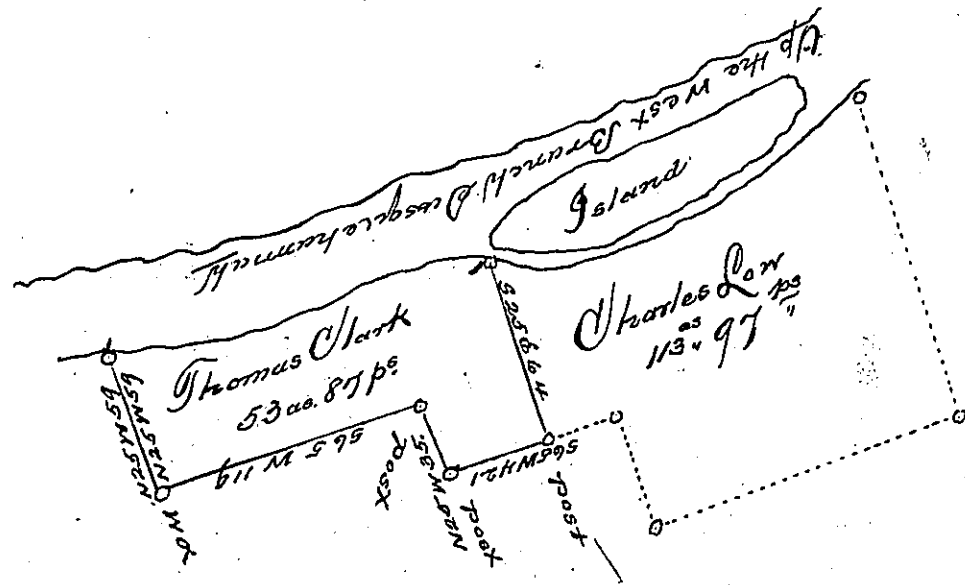


Down the Susquehanna
