



By virtue of an order of the Surveyor General and in pursuance of a warrant dated the 16th day of ^{August} ~~November~~ 1793, there was surveyed on the 23rd day of November 1793 unto Robert Larson the above Tract of Land containing 306^{ac} 1/2^{pc} and allowance situated on a road which empties into Big Fishing Creek, then in Northumberland County but now in Mount Pleasant Township, Columbia County by William Montgomery J. and now to wit on the 23rd day of December 1823. Resurveyed by order of resurvey dated the 16th day of December 1823. and find the content to be 217^{ac} 1/2^{pc} 105^{ac} 1/2^{pc} allowance after excluding the interferences.
