



Situated on the <sup>town</sup> Frankes branch of Genietal in Morris Township Huntingdon County,  
 the piece marked B contains 89 acres 56 perches & allowance and the piece marked  
 A contains sixteen acres & 60 perches & allowance are parts of two tracts of land  
 first surveyed in pursuance of two orders of survey No. 703 & No. 704, res-  
 pectively dated the 1<sup>st</sup> of August A.D. 1766, No. 703 was said to contain  
 246 acres & allowance of 6 p.c., No. 704, was said to contain 298 1/4 Acs.  
 & allowance of 6 p.c. These parts re surveyed & divided from the  
 residue of said tracts the 22<sup>nd</sup> of April 1830, & re examined & approved  
 of the 3<sup>rd</sup> of March 1830
