



In pursuance of a warrant bearing date August 29th 1785 Surveyed on the 31st May 1786 unto Thomas Campbell the above described tract of Land situate in Salem Township Westmoreland County on Loyalhanna Creek containing three hundred & thirty five acres & allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Surveyed by John Moore Esq^r then Deputy Surveyor. Of which tract of Land the above described is a part containing one hundred & fifty eight acres one hundred & nineteen perches & allowance proportioned at six per cent for roads &c.
