



The above is a draught of a survey called Vacant land situate on the drains of the Monongahela river in the Horse-shoe, in Followfield township, Wash^g county. This tract was first surveyed November 5th 1807, on a warrant granted Hugh Cunningham dated the 30th day of May 1804; but having not been returned to the Land office, was again resurveyed on the same warrant January 29th 1820. Containing 16 acres 2 Roods and 29 perches and the usual allowance of six per cent.
