



The Draught of a tract of land situate in Brush Valley Miles Township Centre County Containing one hundred and seventy one acres, one hundred & forty three perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c^a. Surveyed the 2nd day of April 1813 in pursuance of a warrant granted to John Clark dated the 8th day of October 1810.

On the above described tract of land there is a two story square log House & a Stable, about four or five acres of Cleared land, and a family residing on the same first improvement in June 1810.
