Containing 258 acres & 49 perches with the allowance of six per cent. The improvements are two small houses with William Clark residing therein with 40 acres cleared land in the possession of Wm. Clark - part of the cleared land is claimed by John Clark Sn^r. Note this survey includes part of a tract survey to Charles Prier on application of 1769 N^o 2530
