



A Draft of a Tract or Parcel of Land situate in Guilford Township in the County of Franklin (formerly in the County of Cumberland) Containing two hundred and thirty four Acres and 27 Perches and the Allowance of Six p. Cent for Roads &c.<sup>a</sup> being Part of a Tract of Land formerly survey'd (under the Direction of John Armstrong Esq.<sup>r</sup> late Deputy Surveyor.) in pursuance of a Warrant granted to John Cowdon bearing Date the 10<sup>th</sup> Day of June 1762. The Part above described surveyed and laid off for Martin Winger December 17<sup>th</sup> 1790.
