By John Hoge<sup>th</sup> Deputy Surveyor of Washington County, in pursuance of a Warrant granted Caleb Crain the 26<sup>th</sup> day of March 1793. Containing 108 Acres with the allowance of Six per Cent for Roads &c. Situate on the Waters of Ruffs Creek Washington County Now Green Called vintage.
