



A Drought of "Mitchell's" Island Situate in the Susquehanna River in the township of Great Bend, Susquehanna County, and being about three miles above the Bridge across Same River at Great Bend. Surveyed the twenty eight day of April A.D. 1856 for Wright Chamberlain, which Survey is adopted and approved by me in pursuance of his Warrant, bearing date the Sixteenth day of May A.D. 1856. Containing ten acres and twenty one perches of land. Strict Measure, four feet above low water mark.
