



A Draft of a tract of land situated in the township of Stirley in the county of Huntingdon containing three hundred and ninety two acres one hundred and fifty four perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. It being a part of a tract containing five hundred and eighty four acres and allowance which was surveyed in pursuance of a warrant granted to George Croghan dated the 7th day of July 1762. Divided from the residue of said tract this twenty first day of December 1886. [Bearings according to the Magnetic Meridian of 1765 7]
