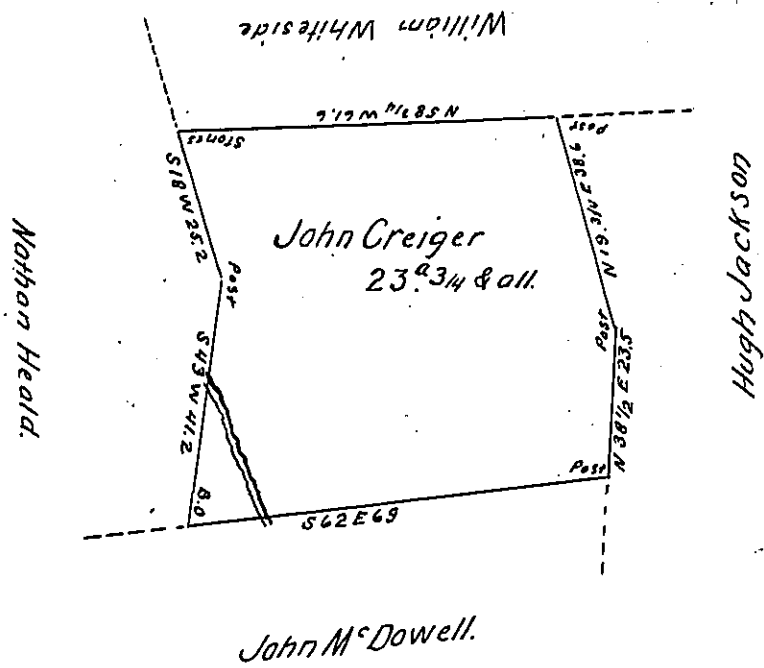


"Scale of 40 to the Inch"
