The above Survey is returned from a Survey as above stated made by George Eckert junr then Deputy Surveyor of Berks County, Copy of which is in this Office, and I went on the ground on the 13th day of January A.D. 1854 and the lines have been traced & the corners found to agree in date with the said Survey, only the line along Strubhauer's ought to be N 9 W. instead of N 9 E. otherwise the survey will not close, being unimproved land, Situate in Pine Grove township Schuylkill County (formerly Berks County) for John Boyer, in right of Asimor Boyer Given under my hand in the Borough of Pine Grove this 18th day of Jan^y A.D. 1854.
