



Situate one mile South of Castleman's River, Between said River & Negroe Mountain, now in Elk Lick Township Somerset County, and originally Surveyed the 21st day of March 1785. In pursuance of a Warrant dated the 27th day of January 1785 Granted to James Claypole for 300^a & includes his Improvement first begun the 1st day of March 1782 - And the whole tract then Called 322⁹/₂ & allowance was returned into the S. G.'s Office - The whole Tract is now found to Contain 328⁹/₂ 165^{ps} & all. The above draught of 297⁹/₂ 103^{ps} is part of the whole & is intended to be Coupled in patenting with 83⁹/₂ 79^{ps} & all, to Jacob Brenisen.
