

Part of 202 acres and allowance Originally Surveyed to Richard Crane by Virtue of a Warrant bearing date the 2d day of September 1737 and also by Vacating Warrant to John Hess and Michael Isserman dated November the 22d 1749.

Resurveyed the above for Jacob Eisenhower the 17<sup>th</sup> day of April 1821
