



Situate in Monaghan (alias Manahan) Township in the County of York containing within the black lines as above set forth 184 ⁹⁵/₁₀₀ & 96 Perches and Allowance. Being part of a larger Tract of 195 ⁹⁵/₁₀₀ & allowance, which was originally surveyed by John Forsyth late D.S. on the 13th day of June 1787 for Baliff Kennedy in pursuance of a warrant granted to Charles Colson bearing date the 18th day of October 1753. Divided off from the said larger Tract of Land the 15th day of May 1807 and now at the request of John Fickes the present owner the same has been calculated examined & found to be correct and returned for confirmation June 21st 1821.
