



Situate in Henry Clay township, Fayette County and Surveyed the— day of November 1833 In pursuance of a warrant in the name of Rob^t Cobby for 400^{as} dated the 10th day of February 1794. No improvement on this land

At the time of the Survey of "John Cobby" the lines of this tract were not known and it was made to interfere with the northwest side of this Survey, however the Surveys both now belong to A. Stewart Esq who says he would rather pay the State a second time for the interference than encounter the delay and expense of a Resurvey, especially at this time, when the mountain is covered with snow and lines & corners hard to be found
