



In pursuance of the settlement begun by Conrad Hawks and continued by Thomas Campbell Esqr. was surveyed for the heirs of said Campbell on the sixth day of June 1837 the above described tract of land situate in Hayfield Township Crawford County containing 458 acres 72 perches and allowance of six per cent for roads &c. being the same tract entered in Book B, page 7 in my office, as surveyed to Conrad Hawks, the 10th day of October 1794 and as then containing 431^{ac} 45 perches in pursuance of his improvement, bearing date the 10th day of April 1793, I do hereby certify that it does not appear from the Books or documents in my office that the above described tract of land has been otherwise appropriated than as above stated
