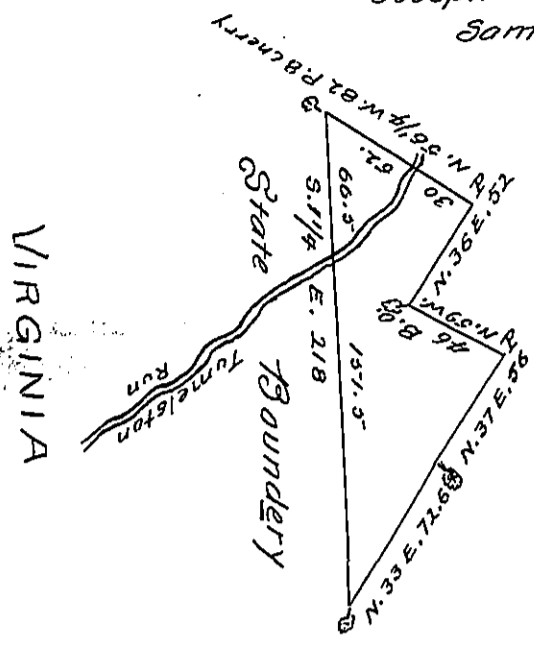

The above draft represents a survey made in pursuance of a warrant granted by the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania to Samuel Carothers of Hanover Township, in the County of Beaver dated 2nd day of Decer 1835 for fifty six acres of Land having actually surueyed the same as above Represented, situated in Hanover Township, Beaver County adjoining Lands with the Virginia State Boundary on the west, Jonathan Hoge on the South East, & Reece Mercer on the E. and other lands of said Carothers on the North, Including fifty one acres & one hundred & forty two perches and allowance of six Pr. Ct. for Roads &c. enclosing a large and ancient improvement and Message, given under my hand at South Beaver Township, Beaver County, February 3rd 1836 by me
