Draught of fifty nine acres and seventy three perches of land with allowance of Six per Cent for roads &c. Situate in Delaware township Juniata County (formerly Farmanagh township Cumberland County) Surveyed the 22<sup>d</sup> day of April 1765 in pursuance of a warrant from the Honorable Proprietors to Samuel Hunter, bearing date at Philadelphia the 20<sup>th</sup> day of July 1755.
