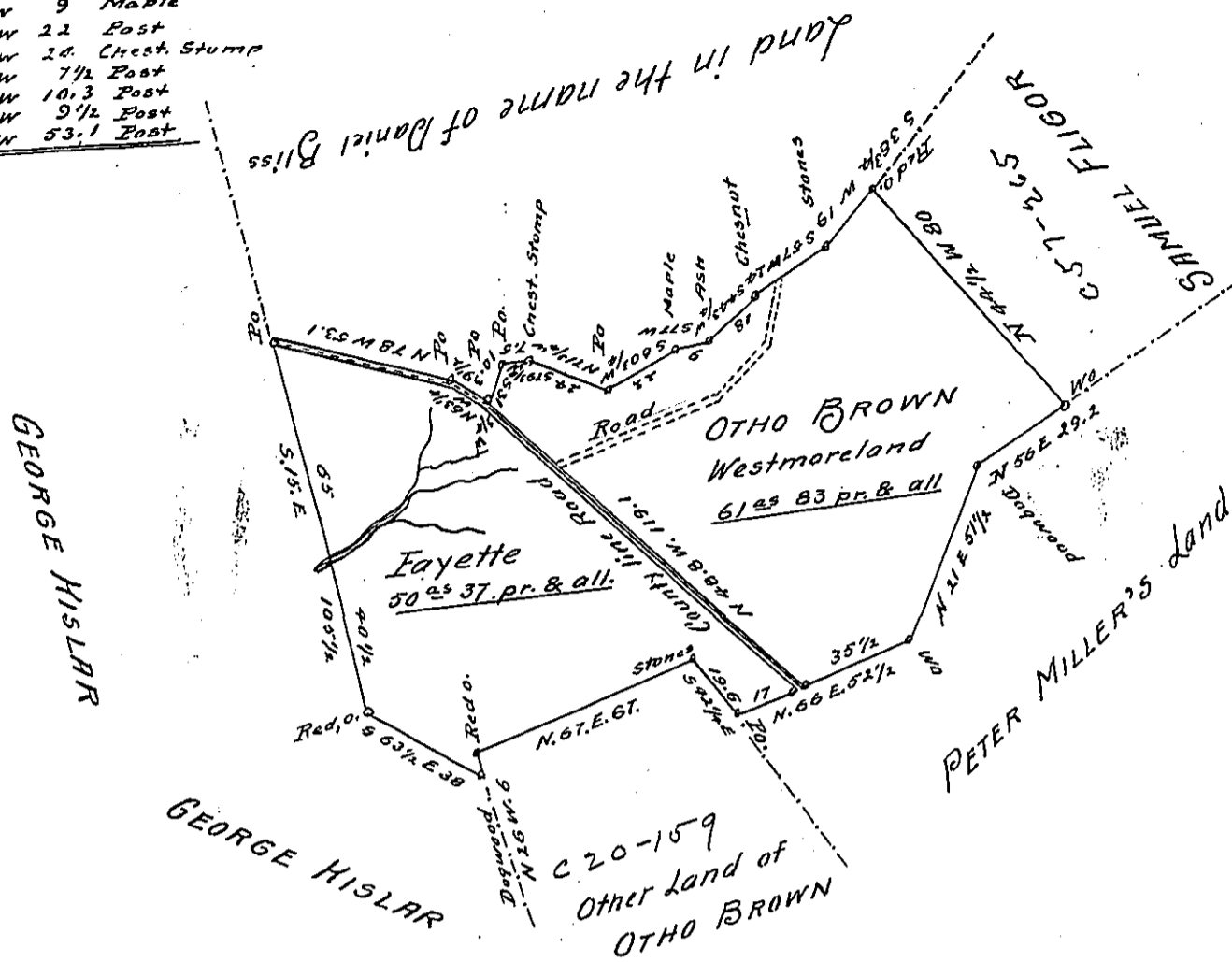

Surveyed April 16th 1841 the above described tract of land for Otho Brown situate in Donegal & Salt lick townships, Westmoreland & Fayette Countys, the part in Westmoreland County contains Sixty one acres & Eighty three perches & allowance, and the part in Fayette County, Fifty acres and thirty seven perches and allowance, and in the whole One hundred eleven acres and three quarters, and the usual allowance, which was this day sold by Nicholas Lozer to the said Otho Brown, to whom a warrant was since granted for the same, to wit the 2^d day of August 1844, and in pursuance of said Warrant, I Return the Survey as above, heretofore made &c.
