



The above is a draught of a survey called *Farmelie* made April 27<sup>th</sup> 1787 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to Joseph Clark dated March 14<sup>th</sup> 1787. It is situated on the waters of *Chartiers Creek* in *Washington County* and contains two hundred and twenty eight acres and a quarter together with the usual allowance of 6. pr Cent for Roads &c.
