



Situate on Laurelhill in Georges township, Fayette County including "Robins's horse camp" Surveyed on a warrant to Joseph Coldwell for 200 a<sup>s</sup> dated 23<sup>d</sup> February, 1788. But the survey of 5<sup>th</sup> November 1835 being found incorrect, it has been resurveyed & corrected in pursuance of an order of the Board of Property to me directed, bearing date the 13<sup>th</sup> Dec<sup>r</sup> 1836

There is no improvement on this tract.

The above survey was made by my predecessor which appears to be correct.
