Note - The eleven acres and forty nine perches & allowance marked off in the above diagram by a poped line was surveyed to Michael Poorman in pursuance of his warrant dated the 9th June 1823 the 18th day of Nov. 1830 and lately patented to him &c. Chambers claims the land by his older survey made on the ground well marked long before Poorman's the poped line was made at the laying of Poorman's warrant &c.
