



The above is a draught of a survey made May the 23rd A.D. 1837 in pursuance of warrant granted to Joseph Campsey dated March the thirteenth 1837 for eighty acres of land containing eighty one acres and fourteen poles and allowance of six per cent. Situate (in the township of Donegal and County of Washington) on the waters of Buffalo creek - the greater part of the above land has been improved thirty or forty years and claimed by Samuel Stokely
