



Draft of a tract of land situate in Boggs township Centre County containing thirty acres & ninety four perches & allowance & ca which only remains of the original survey made November 22<sup>nd</sup> 1806 upon which 310<sup>as</sup> 100<sup>ps</sup> & allowance was returned in pursuance of a warrant granted to Wm Boggs dated 21<sup>st</sup> October 1806 - the remainder of said tract being included within two older surveys in the names of William Carrpbell & Christ<sup>r</sup> Elliott. Resurveyed 28<sup>th</sup> August A.D. 1849 in pursuance of an Order of the Board of Property granted to Thomas Burnside dated the 11<sup>th</sup> December 1848.
