



Draft of two hundred and thirty eight acres and one hundred and eleven perches of land with six per Cent for roads. Situate in Wayne township in Mifflin County surveyed 6<sup>th</sup> April 1815 in pursuance of a Warrant to Frederick Grubach dated 4<sup>th</sup> April 1814. Note there was a family living on the above represented land and several acres of it in cultivation at time of survey.

Note, it appears to me that the part coloured red is within a survey made 23<sup>rd</sup> May 1775 on an order to Zachariah Rickets dated 25<sup>th</sup> Nov: 1766 No. 1967
