



A Draught of an Island situate in the river Susquehanna in Drumore Township Lancaster County. Called Rock Island opposite to land of David Brown on the Lancaster Shore and Land of John Boyd on the York Shore about one hundred & fifty perches from the Lancaster shore and nearly West of Said Samuel Boyds Island known by the name of Duck Island containing forty eight perches and one half Strict Measure Surveyed in Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 23d. of January A.D. 1816, granted to the said Samuel Boyd, March 2nd 1816
