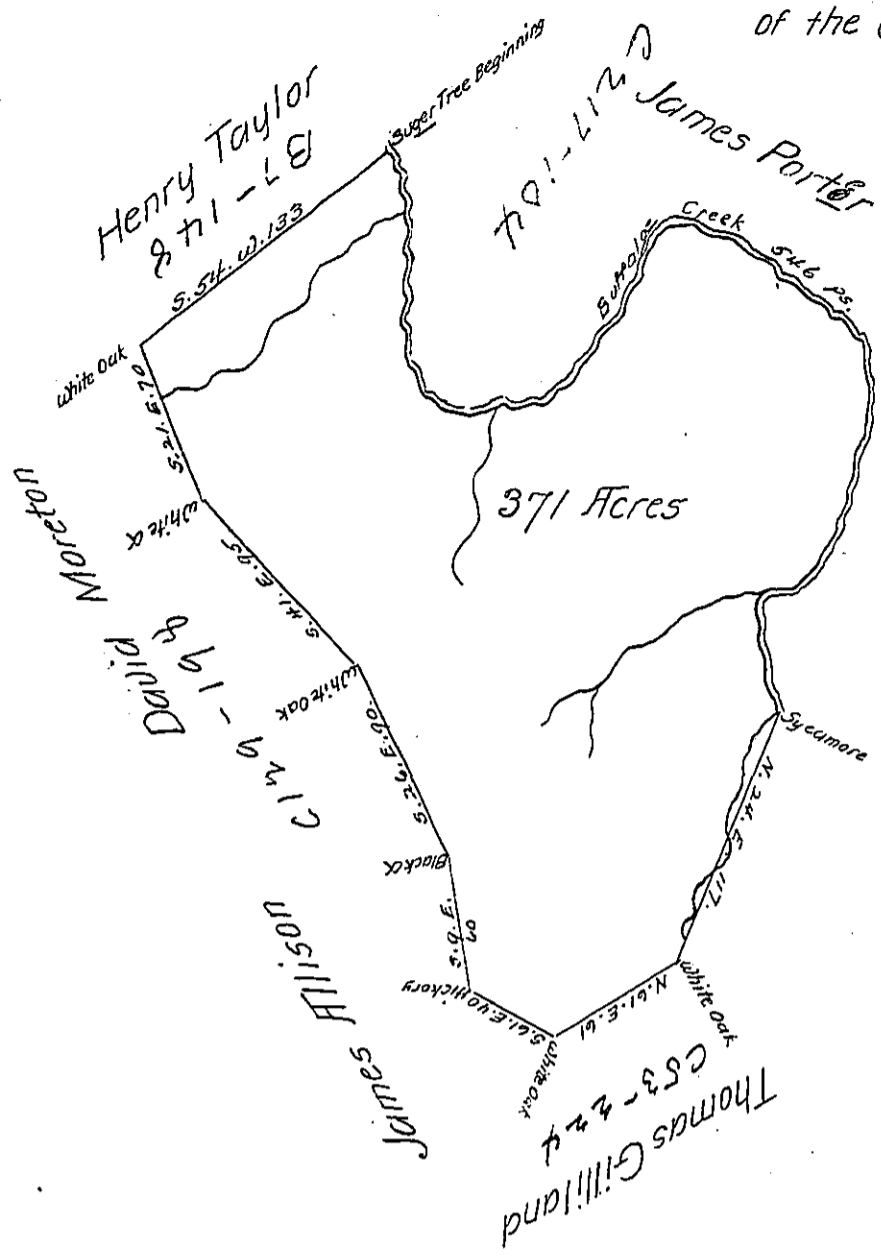


From the Beginning Sugar Tree the Meanders of the Creek is as follows.
