In Pursuance of an Order from the Commissioners of Property dated the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3^d day of July 1772 for Nicholas Cosfiel on a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town ^{Two} hundred and Eight. Containing in Breadth East and West on Poakberry Street Sixty feet and in Length North and South Two hundred and Thirty feet Bounded Southward by Poakberry Street aforesaid, Eastward by Lot Number Two hundred and Seven Northward by Gooseberry Alley and westward by Lot Number Two hundred and Nine. Returned into the Secretary's Office the 9th day of January 1775 for Nicholas Cosfiel by Warrant dated the 4th day of the same Month.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this third day of May 1904.
