



A Draught of a Lot of Ground in the Town of Carlisle in the County of Cumberland marked in a General Plan of said Town No 141 Situate on the West side of Hanover Street and adjoining the South side of the Center Square containing in Breadth on Hanover ~~Street~~ Street Sixty feet and in Length two hundred and forty feet - Bounded Northward part by the Center Square and part by Lot No 142 Westward part by Lot No 124 and part by the End of a Twenty feet Alley Southward by Lot No 140 and Eastward by Hanover Street - Returned into the Secretary's Office the 17<sup>th</sup> day of June 1772 by Warrant granted to Robert Callender dated the 15<sup>th</sup> Instant -
