



Situate in Dover township in the County of York Containing as above set forth 94 a.s. & 80 Perches and Allowance. Surveyed the 25th day of May 1819, in pursuance of a Warrant for 104 a.s. granted to John Behler in trust for Elizabeth Henizen, David Cook and the Heirs of David Whitmer deceased bearing date the 11th day of March 1819. N.B. the Improvement on the above described Tract of Land at the time of Surveying the same consisted of three dwelling Houses a Shop, Barn and Stabling rendering it an actual personal resident settlement with the manifest intention of making it a place of abode and means of supporting a family
