Note that part of the above tract represented by the oblong of A, makes an interference of 2 acres 2 roods & 3/4 of an Acre with a Survey in the name of Elias Davison upon a Location now the property of Jeremiah McCreey Esq. The residue of said Tract includes all the Survey of Henry Prater. Executed upon Location No. 2535, granted by Col. Boquet Nov. 18th of 62. to Thomas Small on Turtle Creek, now in possession of John Patterson, Tenant of John B. Alexander of Greens. Situate part in Plum Township, Allegh. Co. & the Sd. all land in Westmoreland County
